Licking County Library Meetings Changed

Newark, Ohio - The Finance Committee of the Board of Trustees of the Licking County Library has changed its meeting to Thursday, March 19, 2009, at 4:00 pm in the Lower Level Story Hour Room of the Newark Library at 101 W. Main Street, Newark. As a result of this change, the meeting of the full Board of Trustees has been moved to Thursday, March 26, 2009, at 4:00 pm in the Lower Level Story Hour Room of the Newark Library. These changes were made so that the most up-to-date distributions from the State's *Public Library Fund* can be used in completing work on the Library's permanent budget for its General Fund.

Licking County Library has served Newark and Licking County since 1908. Today, there are six convenient locations, including: Newark Library in downtown Newark; Emerson R. Miller Library in west Newark; Hervey Memorial Library in Utica; Hebron Library; Buckeye Lake Library; and Mary E. Babcock Library in Johnstown. A Bookmobile provides outreach services throughout Licking County.
